Will you put yourself forward to be a Parish Councillor?

Following the resignation of a long-standing Councillor who has moved away from the area, there is currently one vacancy. This may be filled by co-option.

The Parish Council has been instrumental in setting up the Landewednack Housing Working Party, and the current Affordable Homes project is looking to build affordable houses, in conjunction with Cornwall Community Land Trust, on land currently owned by the Parish Council.

Councillors, collectively, have the opportunity to respond to Cornwall Council Planning Applications. All four Public Access Defibrillators in the Village are maintained by the Parish Council. Public Rights of Way benefit from additional funding from LPC. The Landewednack Lawn Cemetery and the Public Toilets are other areas under the jurisdiction of LPC.
