There are two vacancies on Landewednack Parish Council

The council will fill these vacancies by co-option, which is a process where the council considers applications from interested people and can then select someone to fill the seat.

We need people from all backgrounds and experiences to put themselves forward for this role. The role of a Parish Councillor is to represent the interests of the whole community and to take an active role in the decision-making process. You do not need any specific experience or qualifications, bring your life experiences, everyday skills and commitment to people and the local community.

Applications received before the agenda is published will be included on the agenda for the next scheduled council meeting. Applicants will have the opportunity to attend the meeting and give a short introduction about themselves if they wish to.

Information:

Applicants must be at least 18 years old, and a British citizen, or an eligible Commonwealth or EU Citizen. Applicants must also meet at least one of the following four qualifications:

- 1) Be registered on the electoral roll
- 2) Have occupied, as owner or tenant, land, or other premises in the parish during the whole of the past 12 months
- 3) The main or only place of work during the past 12 months has been in the parish
- 4) Have lived in the parish or within three miles of it during the whole of the past 12 months
