### **AIM OF MEETING**

The aim of this meeting was to:

1. Outline the role and working limitations of the working group.
2. Draw up a list of key issues to be addressed.
3. Draw up a list of other agencies to be consulted or invited to join the working group.

### **DISCUSSIONS**

1. The role and working limitations of the working group were explained, using the notes agreed by the Parish Council for the establishment and running of the Traffic Management Working Group.
2. A list of key issues was drawn up. It was agreed that this list could be added to, or issues merged as work progressed. The initial issues were:
  - Kynance Cove Junction.
  - Entrance to recycling site.
  - Parking outside Witchball.
  - Parking along Beacon Terrace.
  - National Trust parking.
  - Improved traffic signs and road marking.
  - Speed through village.
  - Parking capacity.
  - Pathways (along roads).
  - Traffic flow along Lighthouse Road.
  - Traffic flow around village.

These issues would be put to the parish Council for approval.

3. A list of other agencies to be consulted or invited to join the working group. As with issues, the list was not considered exhaustive and could be added to as required. The initial list comprised:

- National Trust.
- Cornwall Council Highways.
- Police.
- Other Parish Councils (through the Community Network Panel).
- Bus company.

This list would be put to the Parish Council for approval.
