24/25-	APM 2	<p>The Chair: Cllr B Kessell, as Chair, welcomed attendees to the 2024/25 Parishioners' Meeting and reported thus:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Internet has been installed in the Reading Room, improving accessibility for all. • The Small Green has been repaired and re-seeded and re-turfed as appropriate and the benches have been maintained and re-sited for the summer season. • Road Safety on the A3083 entrance to the village has been high on the agenda and lobbying by The Clerk and Parishioners' letters has resulted in the installation of a vehicle activated safety sign. • Tennis court nets have been replaced on the Recreation Ground • Following a Public Hearing, confirmation has now been received that the status of the land known as The Green is retained as Common Land • The Parish Council received a kind donation of a new bench for the Lawn Cemetery and have added two additional new benches. • The oldest village defibrillator has been replaced. There are 4 defibrillators in the village, and all will shortly have bleed kits installed. • The Parish Council continues to maintain and run the Public Toilets with no external Council funding. • The Clerk has lobbied the MP in relation to the vulnerability of parts of the village with the introduction of Digital Voice. The Government initiative has now been delayed ensuring that a timely viable alternative is available to those residents who experience poor mobile signals and who are vulnerable to power cuts. • Landewednack Parish Council continues to work with Cornwall Community Land Trust to develop Affordable Housing provision at the entrance to the village. Houses, when built, will only be allocated via the Cornwall Council Home Choice system.
