Small Pavillion – A request has been made for the model railway to be stored here. Approved in principle, subject to sufficient space and owner having insurance cover for the equipment whilst in storage. Small Pavillion Insurance policy to be updated to cover Christmas decorations, road furniture and fire safety equipment – Secretary to action. (Football & Social club is responsible for its own insurance policy).
22/23	14RGT	 Play Area: Replacement of Pea Gravel on the Playground: Quotations are being obtained for this work which is likely to be in the region of £50,000 plus VAT. This could be by matting, an complete resurface or designated mat areas. Grant funding will be necessary, which may be forthcoming under disability access provision since the area is currently inaccessible to wheelchairs. Secretary & Trustees to investigate. E Amiss will pass on a contact to the Secretary. Safety Reports; These are conducted monthly with an annual inspection. The pea gravel is technically acceptable within the safety rules however numerous complaints have been received and there are issues with access (see above).
