22/23	27RGT	<p>Events: Permission requested and granted for The Lizard Vintage Car Rally Sunday 27th August 2023. Coronation events may include Beacon, Pipers, Tregullas Farm are planning a Big Lunch – action needed to secure the Pipers’ services</p>
22/23	28RGT	<p>Football Club: Trustees expressed concern about the condition of the ground following use. Secretary to ask contractor if there is any remedial work recommended.</p>
22/23	29RGT	<p>Projects & Action List : Tennis Court Netting: In the absence of information from elsewhere, new Trustee A Pascoe, a keen tennis player, was asked to research the requirements for a replacement net. Quotation to replace the tennis court fences to be chased Wall to the right of the entrance – Openreach has replaced a telegraph pole and repaired the damage this caused to the wall. The Trustees authorised a further stretch of repair to this area of the wall which had been in a poor state for a few years. Cost approved at £1290 plus VAT</p>
22/23	30GT	<p>Play Area: Replacement of Pea Gravel on the Playground: Quotations are still being obtained for this work which is likely to be in the region of £50,000 plus VAT. This could be by matting, a complete resurface or designated mat areas. Grant funding will be necessary, which may be forthcoming under disability access provision since the area is currently inaccessible to wheelchairs. Information to be requested from the Beyond the Wave CIC re disability access grant funding contact. Safety Reports; These are conducted monthly with an annual inspection which is due in April 2023</p>
