**Minutes of the Meeting of the Landewednack Parish Council as Sole Trustee of the Lizard Recreation Ground Trust held on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> June 2025 at The Lizard Reading Room.**

<b>25/26-</b>	<b>1RGT</b>	<b>To receive and accept apologies:</b> Apologies were received from E Amiss and I Fiske.
<b>25/26-</b>	<b>2RGT</b>	<b>Minutes of the Meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> March 2025:</b> The minutes were <b>approved</b> .
<b>25/26</b>	<b>3RGT</b>	<b>Events:</b> The VE Day Beacon on the evening of 8 <sup>th</sup> May 2025 was cancelled because of the overlap with Flora Day and the Club being closed. The Community Group will be holding various events during the summer, including Feast Day races -22 <sup>nd</sup> June and The Lizard Fun Day – 17 <sup>th</sup> August.
<b>25/26-</b>	<b>4RGT</b>	<b>To Consider matters relating to the Football &amp; Social Club.</b> Receipts continue to be up, and the club is doing well with refurbishment well underway. Various events are planned. A smart meter will be installed at the clubhouse which opens the possibility of solar panel installation. There has been a broken window at the clubhouse, thought to have been caused by trimmer action. The Grounds Contractor has been in discussion to reach resolution with affected parties. Likewise a nearby building – which is also being mentioned as part of the National Grid review (see below).
<b>25/26-</b>	<b>5RGT</b>	<b>Other matters, including Projects:</b> National Grid have been contacted about the state of the ground after their works.
<b>25/26</b>	<b>6RGT</b>	<b>Play Area</b> Trustees inspected the area following the annual safety inspection and report in April 2025. Local contractors to be asked to repair the wooden fence slats. Repairs to the equipment are agreed to be necessary and a quotation obtained. Landewednack Parish Council has agreed to fund the replacements and repairs from Community Infrastructure Levy funds. Thanks were expressed to LAF&SC for their vigilance regarding littering in the area even when the patrons of the Club do not cause this.
<b>24/25</b>	<b>49RGT</b>	<b>Accounts:</b> It was <b>agreed</b> to approve payments as provided by the Secretary and ongoing payments as required to maintain contracts and safety. There are sufficient funds at present to meet the cost of ongoing Grounds work, as per the agreed contracts.
