14th May 2026 LPC Minutes

26055. Report from Cornwall Councillor:

CCRG was welcomed to the meeting and gave a report including:

- I. **Public Realm:** Reiterating the apology from Cornwall Council and confirming that there would be non-chemical control of vegetation within the allotted areas for 2026-27. In December 2026, the Health and Safety executive is reviewing the use of glyphosates.
- II. **Learn Cornish Podcast:** There are BBC Podcasts every Friday to encourage an accessible approach to learning the Cornish Language.
- III. **Community Chest Fund:** CCRG's Community Chest Fund is now open for applications. Funds are limited, Application forms available from CCRG
- IV. **Speed Limit alterations in The Lizard Village:** CCRG has protested to CC and has met with similar response to that received by LPC in 2024. He has been informed that the changes meet the Central Government Criteria for rural roads, including 20mph increasing to 60mph. CCRG will arrange to meet with LPC Cllrs to discuss how best to take this forwards. The road from Kynance Cove exiting onto the A3083, (60mph at that point with no speed restrictions nearby) presents an extremely dangerous junction.
